The moderated forum will include discussion of:

- Existing state and utility programs and how they can be improved, including inter-agency coordination.
- The sharing of benefits from efficiency and renewable energy between property owners and building residents.
- Access to financing for efficiency and other clean energy options and its role in meeting the state's energy savings and emissions reductions goals.
- How utilities and the State communicate with the populations they serve.

This forum presents an opportunity for attendees to offer information to New York State and utility representatives on energy efficiency and energy affordability, based on their experiences with low and moderate income households and affordable housing.
